Reason why Restricted:* Not on approved list


Reason for Need: Sowbug/ pillbug populations have increased to the point where they are now infesting building spaces. EcoExempt G is a granular formulation and should allow for some residual abilities. All ingredients are natural and listed on the label including the inert ingredients.

Options/Alternatives EcoExempt G is a new approach to insect control. The Granular formulation is all natural and will create a barrier to prevent insect populations from encroaching into building spaces.

Plan to Preclude Future Use: Using IPM will help to address future concerns. When no problems exist, no pest control activities should be considered.
