Active Ingredient: 10% Rosemary Oil, 2% Peppermint Oil
Amount of Material Needed: 2.5 gallons Eco-Exempt IC2

Location of Proposed Use: Exterior treatment of Marin County Civic Center: 1) Adm. Building 2) Hall of Justice & 3) Jail

Reason why Restricted:* Product is not restricted, Eco-Exempt IC2 is an approved material, requesting 1 day posting exemption so that the area can be treated today (Friday) after the offices close – site will be posted.

Reason for Need: Sow Bug populations in the above areas have increased beyond acceptable numbers. An external application of Eco-Exempt IC2 is needed around the perimeter of the building to help reduce the numbers of sow bugs entering the interior of the buildings.

Options/Alternatives: Increased monitoring and use of IPM practices to reduce Sow Bug populations before they become an infestation.

Plan to Preclude Future Use: Sealing points of access to prevent entry into the internal areas of the buildings (use of weather-stripping, caulking, etc...).

Time Period Needed: Desired application on 7/08/11 Friday after 5:30pm to minimize employee or visitor contact with material.
