Amount of Material Needed: Up to 128 oz. for turf application

Location of Proposed Use: Lagoon Park Island

Reason why Restricted:* This product is not on the Marin County IPM Use List. It is not organic but has the properties we look for in an "allowed use" product. The Exemption Request is for the new product and for use of this product on turf. As part of the IPM policy we do not make applications to turf unless the area is fenced off from the public. Currently the site is fenced and will remain fenced for at least the 4 days after application.

Reason for Need: The island in the lagoon recently had a major renovation and sod was placed on approximately one acres. Weeds have come up sporadically in the new sod. We will need to eliminate the weeds that exist on the site or the investment will be lost.


Options/Alternatives: The invasive weeds currently on the site cannot be economically removed by mechanical weeding in a timely manner.
