Proposed Material: EVAC Botanical rodent repellent

Active Ingredient: Balsam Fir oil

Amount of material needed: Product comes in 2.5 oz. pouches. Each lasts up to one month and then must be replaced. This is for a blanket use of the product.

Location of Proposed Use: Product to be used in Marin County vehicles to reduce incidents of rodent destroying vital parts (i.e. brake lines and electrical wiring.)

Reason why Restricted: This product is not currently on the IPM use list but meets all requirements for our least toxic products. It will be added to our use list next year if it works well.

Reason for Need: Rodents have been documented damaging brake lines and electric wiring in county vehicles

Options/Alternatives: Rodent traps have been placed and are monitored.

Plan to Preclude Future Use: This may be an ongoing product if it is successful in reducing damage to vehicles
