

IPM Volunteer Highlights 1st Quarter 2011 report

- French Broom removal at Stafford Lake Park on January 30th, 22 Volunteers.
- IPM work at McInnis Park in January totaled 225 hours from 11 Volunteers. Work consisted of hand weeding, gopher trapping, litter pick-up and weed whipping.
- STRAW (Students and Teachers Restoring a Watershed) work at Creekside Park on January 28th, 139 Volunteers worked for a total of 390 hours. Students, teachers and Bay Institute staff worked to removal Harding glass and install native plants for tidal wetland and upland habitat restoration.
- Gift of Love Volunteer Event on February 13th, 147 Volunteers worked at 4 different locations for a total of 441 hours. Work consisted of hand weeding at Stafford Lake Park, Fennel removal at McInnis Park, sheet mulching at the Civic, and weeding, mulching and litter removal at Bayside Park.
- Alpha Gamma Sigma group from College of Marin at McNear's Beach Park on February 26th, 21 Volunteers. French Broom removal and beach cleanup.
- Community Volunteer Event at the Sausalito/Mill Valley Multi-Use Pathway on February 27th, 41 Volunteers. Work consisting of Acacia pruning, hand weeding around scenic overlooks, litter pick up, Fennel and Himalayan Blackberry removal.
- Litter removal at Agate Beach, 27 hours from 1 Volunteer. Hand weeding at Pt. Reyes Park, 2 Volunteers for 3 total hours.
- Entrance Median renovation at Stafford Lake Park. 15 Volunteers replaced turf from median with drought tolerant natives grasses, shrubs and mulch. Sprinklers were replaced with drip irrigation. 70 total hours from March 27th, 2011. Additional hours worked in April to complete project.
- Community Event at the Tiburon Uplands Nature Preserve on March 27th, 11 Volunteers work to remove French Broom for a total of 44 hours.
- Assigned hours and Community Service hours at the Civic Center totaled 748 hours from 27 Volunteers between January and March 2011. Work consisted of hand weeding and litter pick-up.
