Volunteer Activity at Stafford Lake:

-Cory, litter pick up and French Broom removal at Blackpoint Boat Launch, assistance with installation of goose fencing at Stafford, weedwhip work, 8 total hours.

-Wayne and T, June 14th-16th, picnic table pressure washing at Area 2 and Rustic Meadows, hand weeding and raking at Area 2 and blower work, weed whipping at Rustic Meadows, moving tables, 42 total hours.

-Wayne and T, hand weeding and weedwhipping work on 6/23, 7 total hours.

-Wayne and T, shop cleanup on 6/28, 14 total hours. 6/29- weedwhipping work and park cleanup, finished creek bank from shop to lake, peeler cores from shop to gate, 14 total hours. 6/30- hand weeding gatehouse median curb and blower work, 2 total hours.
